Course Descriptions:

HAZWOPER 8-Hour Refresher Training (Duration - 8 hours)

The HAZWOPER 8 Hour Refresher training is designed to meet the annual refresher training requirements for trainees who have previously received the 40 hour HAZWOPER training. This training is intended to meet the applicable requirements of 29 CFR 1910.120.

Protech ECS has structured this training specifically for laboratory scale emergency response. Training segments include the essential components of emergency response, hazard recognition, exposure control methods, personal protective equipment, respiratory protection and respirator fit testing, emergency response equipment, detection instrumentation, spill remediation, and program review.

DOT Function Specific Training (Duration - 7 hours)

This course is designed to address the specific functions of individuals that directly affect hazardous materials transportation safety for most regulated materials, substances or waste by highway route. Some regulated materials such as shipping of explosives, radioactive materials, and organic peroxides will require extended training beyond the basic information covered in this training.

New Hire Laboratory Orientation (Duration - 1 hour)

The New Hire Laboratory Orientation training is designed to meet the training requirements for employees hired to work in a laboratory or laboratory related operations. Trainees typically work with or in the vicinity of hazardous chemicals, biological agents and radioactive materials. This training will cover the basics of the Injury Illness Prevention Program, Hazard Communications, fire safety, spill response, ergonomics, biological hazards, and waste handling procedures.

Radiation Safety Training (Duration - 1 hour)

The Radiation Safety training is designed to meet the training requirements for trainees who work with or in the vicinity of radioactive materials under their radioactive materials license conditions. The training will cover the basics of radiations interaction with matter, exposure control, pregnant personnel policy, the ALARA philosophy, record keeping, spill response, and waste management.

Bloodborne Pathogen Training (Duration - 1 hour)

The Bloodborne Pathogen training is designed to meet the requirements set forth CCR Title 8, section 5193. Trainees will learn the proper method to identify, evaluate, and control bloodborne pathogen hazards. This training will include the proper methods used to respond to spills and occupational exposures.

Fire Extinguisher Use and Fire Safety (Duration - 1 hour)

The Fire Extinguisher Use and Fire Safety training is designed to meet the training requirements for individuals who may be required to operate a fire extinguisher to extinguish a fire while at work. The training will cover the fire triangle, classes of fires, fire prevention, evacuation procedures, and practical fire extinguisher use exercise.
